The Alliance hosted members of Council and Township Manager Julie Jakubec for a breakfast meet and greet back in August, and since then has maintained open and frequent lines of communication with the Township regarding traffic and safety concerns, litter, and other Park issues. The Board will continue to act as liaison with government to resolve any new or outstanding concerns within the Park.

In the following months, the Board also intends to work closely with Township leadership, the police force, and other first responders to develop and implement a disaster-related and emergency contingency plan.
