OLD BUSINESS:

SAFETY:

- 1. The number one public safety issue has been the fact that workers who go from the bus stop to their jobs, walk in the street where their safety is threatened. We need to be creative in solving this problem, doing so with the cooperation of the Township.
- 2. A second public safety issue is the speeding on Delta (has been called the Delta speedway) where the workers from Cook Myosite must cross over delta when going between their two buildings. George is trying to determine if a speed indicator can be provided as a deterrent to speeding on Delta Drive.
- 3. There is decayed infrastructure including catch basins and curbs, particularly on upper Alpha Drive. The paving of Kappa, and the upgrading of the associated catch basins, was suspended because of an expected reduction in the Township's income because of Covid.
- 4. The Township, before changing the management of the police department, was going to work with us to develop a disaster plan particularly as it relates to how to handle an active shooter. We found out that the Township has created an emergency road behind Giant Eagle. Presumably this road, which has a chain across it, would be part of whatever plan is developed.
- 5. We understand that the Township is planning to develop a 10 year master plan. We need to have input particularly as it relates to investing in infrastructure that relates to improved public safety.
- 6. We need one or more bus stop shelters, the priority being the Gamma Drive bus stop. The Township has been made aware of this need.
